



August PROJECT OF THE MONTH

MINI PIZZA BOX BY JEN DEL MURO

You'll need:

- Loving Mew (N-7508)
- Brown Cardstock
(6" x 11", 2 7/8" x 2 7/8", 2 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2")
- Pink Cardstock (3 - 4" x 4", 3 - 2" x 2" and 2 - 7" x 2 1/2")
- White Cardstock (2 3/4" x 2 3/4", 3 - 2" x 2" and 2 - 2 3/8" x 2 3/8")
- Brilliance Graphite Black
- Brown and Pink ink
- Copic Markers
- Rose Grosgrain Ribbon
- Nestabilities Scalloped Square Dies
- 1 1/4" circle punch
- 1 3/8" and scallop circle punch
- Hole punch
- Silver Brads
- 2 - Small Envelopes
- Scoring Tools and/or ruler
- Adhesives and Glue Dots
- Silver Cord



1

Across the short side of the Brown Cardstock, score 1" in from each side.

2

Across the long side, score at 1", 5", 6" and 10". Cut along red lines as shown on template.

Fold along score lines into box, adhering the sides flaps as you go.

Use the Nestabilities die to cut 3 scallop squares from the 3 - 4" x 4" Pink Cardstock.

On one of the scalloped squares, cut off approximately 1/2" on opposite sides. Do the same to one side on the other square. You should now have 3 pieces with a scallop and a straight edge. Adhere these pieces to the sides of the top of the box and embellish the ends with silver brads. Adhere the remaining scalloped square to top of box.

Stamp "Love Muffin" with the brown and pink ink in straight lines, alternating colors on the White Cardstock. Adhere white piece to brown piece. Wrap a pink ribbon on the top. (*Do not do the bow yet.*) Attach to top of the box using glue dots.

7 Use the scalloped 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " punch on the 2" x 2" Pink Cardstock.

8 With black ink stamp, color and punch out cupcake/muffin image on the 2" x 2" White Cardstock. Use 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " circle punch to punch out image. Use the scalloped 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " punch on the 2" x 2" Pink Cardstock. Attach to Pink scalloped circle. Punch hole in top, string silver cording and brad through. Attach to ribbon on sentiment panel.

(Although you could have created your bow at the end of step 4, I chose to do it separately. Sometimes I find I get a better bow this way. I tied my bow, cut flagged edges and adhered it to the top of the ribbon, hiding the cording with hot glue.)

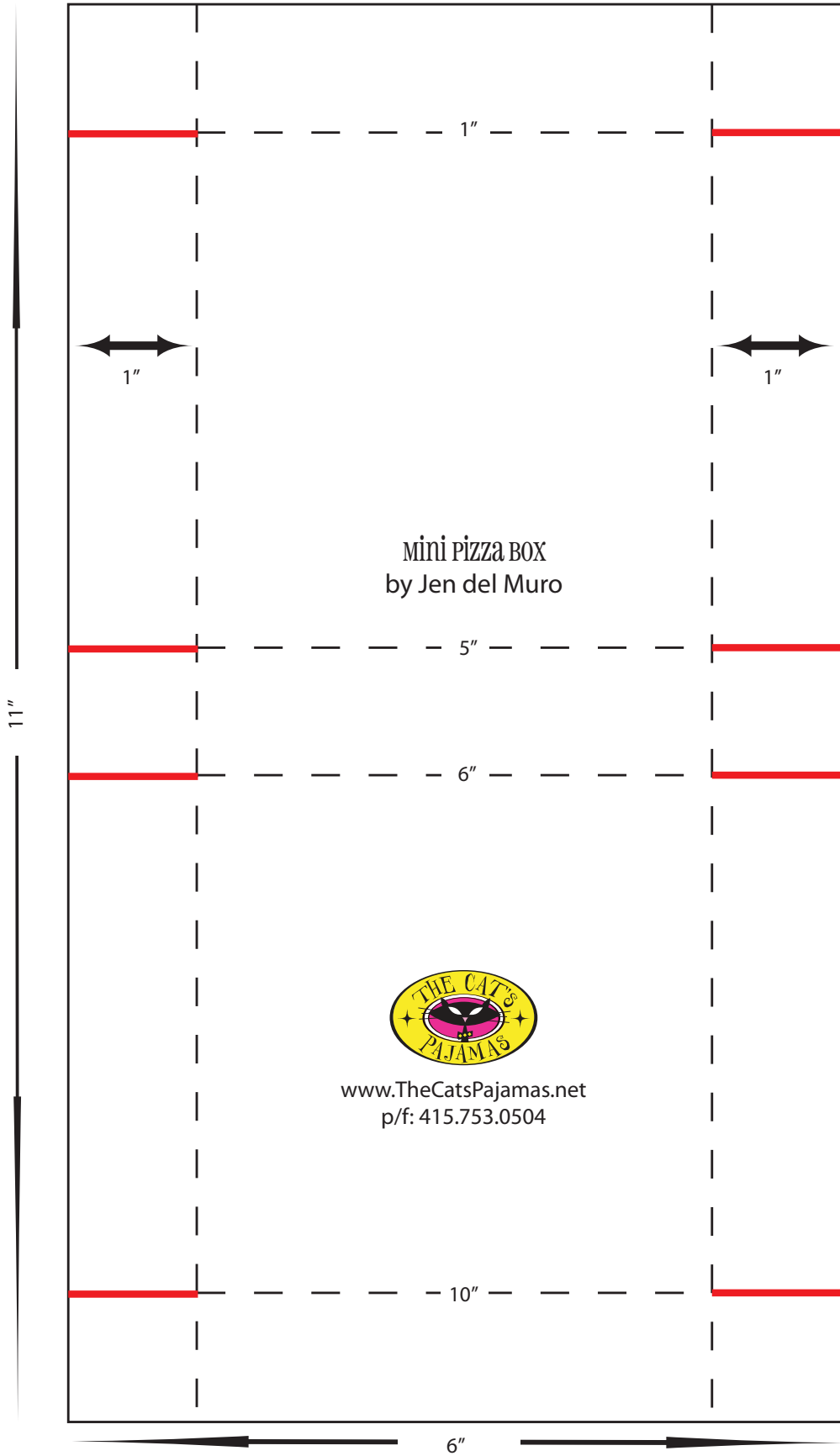
Mini Cards

1 Fold Pink 7" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in half. Place fold below the cutting line in the inside center scalloped die. So that when the paper is cut a folded card is created. Repeat for the second card.

2 On the White 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Cardstock, stamp the "Love Muffin" sentiment in straight lines, alternating brown and pink. Adhere white piece to Brown 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Adhere to card base using dimensional glue dots.

3 Stamp, color and punch (using 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " circle punch) cupcake/muffin image. Mat with 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " and scallop circle punch. Adhere to sentiment panel using dimensional glue dots. Repeat.

You can make as many Mini Cards as you wish, we just made 2.
