



FLIP FLOP COASTERS

You'll Need:

- By The Sea (S-9668 CL)
- Fun in the Sun (N-9670 CL)
- Candy Sprinkles Ribbon (RB-001)
- 1/4" Cork Board 3 1/2" x 4 1/4"
- Patterned Paper 3 1/2" x 4 1/4"
- Scrap cardstock 3 1/2" x 4 1/4"
- Double sided adhesive
- 2 pieces of ribbon, approx. 5" each
- 1/4" hole punch
- Spellbinders largest oval Nestabilities die (3" x 4 1/4") or a freehand drawn flip-flop shape
- Polyshrink plastic
- Stazon ink or other permanent ink pad
- Colored pencils, markers, etc
- Thread

1 Die cut patterned paper and scrap of cardstock using largest oval Nestabilities. Use cardstock oval to trace oval pattern onto cork board and cut out with scissors.

2 Punch 3 holes in patterned paper oval; one at top and two on each side of lower edge, using a wine glass for correct placement in order for your finished flip flop/ribbon straps to fit around and hold wine glass in place.

3 Thread both ends of ribbon pieces through top hole and secure on back with tape.

4 Thread remaining ends through each of the lower holes and secure on back with tape making sure your wine glass will fit inside the ribbon straps you've just created. Adhere flip flop with ribbon straps to matching cork board oval (*I've found using adhesive sheets die cut using the same oval die as the patterned paper works best*)

5 Create polyshrink charm and attach to either ribbon strap using needle & thread.

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- 1** Follow manufacturer's directions to prepare the polyshrink sheet for stamping (*my directions recommended sanded in a crosshatch pattern with 320 to 400 grit sandpaper*).
- 2** Stamp desired image onto polyshrink sheet, let dry completely and color image.
- 3** Cut around image leaving enough room at top for a ¼" hole punch (*you can also use a circle die if you desire a round charm, etc*).
- 4** Shrink your plastic per manufacturer's directions (*I baked mine in a 325° oven for 1-2 min. or use may also use an embossing heat tool*)
