



LET IT SNOW NUGGET CARD BOX

You'll need:

- Penguin Christmas (S-9677 CL)
- Holiday Glitzy Glitter (Glitzy-03)
- 3" square clear boxes
(In the Paper section of the website)
- Ribbon
- (12) Hershey Nuggets
- (12) Address Labels (8160 from Avery)
- Die Cut Chipboard Snowflake
- Cream Colored Acrylic Paint
- Diamond Glaze
- Button
- Twine
- Black Ink
- Brown Ink
- Aqua and Gray Ink
- Dauber or Sponge
- 12" x 2 3/4" Patterned Paper
- 5 3/4" x 2 3/4" Patterned Paper
- 5 5/8" x 2 5/8" Cream Cardstock
- 1" x 3" Coordinating Patterned Paper
- 1 3/4" Circle Coordinating Patterned Paper
- 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" Cream Cardstock
- Hot Glue Gun
- Red-line Tape or Scor-Tape
- Decorative Edge Punch
- Hole Punch

December PROJECT OF THE MONTH

For Nuggets

- Stamp address labels with snowflakes using aqua and gray inks. Wrap Nuggets with address labels.

- Adhere to square cardstock pieces using double sided tape and insert into clear boxes.

For Inside Panel

- Using decorative edge punch, punch long sides of 5 3/4" x 2 3/4" of patterned paper.

- Fold in half. Line up the fold to the edge of one of the boxes and adhere creating "inside" panel. Repeat on other box.

- Sponge edges of 5 5/8" x 2 5/8" cream cardstock with brown ink. Then, stamp snowflakes all over with aqua and gray inks. Stamp sentiment on right side of cardstock. Fold in half and adhere over patterned paper panel on boxes.

For Outside of Box

- Using decorative edge punch, punch the 12" x 2 3/4" piece of pattern paper along long edges.

- With the boxes "closed", wrap them with pattern paper vertically, creasing the paper around the edges of the box. *There will be a slight amount of excess.*



Take the excess, and pinch and adhere together. *You have basically created a flag on the top of the boxes.*

- 3** Fold pattern paper circle in half and place over this flag. Punch holes, string ribbon through and tie a bow on the front side.

For Snowflake

- 1** Paint die cut snowflake with cream colored paint. Allow to dry.

- 2** Place Diamond Glaze where glitter is desired, leaving a small space in the center of the snowflake blank. Sprinkle chunky glass glitter over snowflake. Sprinkle silver glass glitter over snowflake to fill in spaces, creating an extra sparkly snowflake. Set aside and allow snowflake to dry. Tie twine through button in a bow.

- 3** Stamp "Let It Snow" sentiment on 1" x 3" piece of coordinating cardstock. Cut one side into a flag end and trim other side to desired length.

- 4** Adhere button to sentiment strip with hot glue (*Tip: Using hot glue with chunkier embellishments helps insure that they will not fall off your project later*).

When snowflake is dry, adhere sentiment/button panel to center of snowflake using hot glue. Adhere to front panel using hot glue.
