

# HERE COMES SANTA! ACETATE CARD

- 1 Score Acetate at 5" on the long side and fold into a card.
- 2 Using Black ink, stamp Santa in his plane in center of white cardstock. Stamp clouds from Candy train (masking train) above plane. *Stamp candy below plane as if Santa is throwing it down to the kiddies.*
- 3 Color all images using Copic markers or coloring tool of your choice.
- 4 Layer colored piece to pink textured cardstock.
- 5 Use slot punch to punch hole for ribbon in lower left hand corner of layered Santa piece.
- 6 Insert ribbon into slot and tie around with silver cording and make bow. Adhere layered Santa piece to center front of acetate card using foam tape.
- 7 Cut scalloped square from red textured cardstock using Nestabilities die. Place pieces of red-line tape on the back of acetate front, behind the layered pieces. Attach the red scalloped square behind acetate to cover tape.
- 8 Layer patterned paper square to light blue cardstock square.
- 9 Stamp "Here Comes Santa!" in all four corners.
- 10 Adhere patterned paper layer to center of inside of acetate card using red-line tape so that it shows behind the scalloped Santa layer.
- 11 Add glittery details to Santa layer using Red and Silver Stickles Glitter Glue.

- S-8548 Candyland Christmas Clear Set
- Clear Acetate — 5" x 10"
- White Cardstock - 2 1/2" square
- Patterned Paper - 4" square
- Light Blue Cardstock - 4-1/8" square
- Tuxedo Black Memento ink
- Copic Markers
- Pink Textured cardstock — 2-5/8" square
- Slot Punch
- Nestabilities Dies
- Coordinating Ribbon — 3 — 4" lengths
- Silver Cording
- Red-Line Tape (Terrifically Tacky Tape)
- Red & Silver - Ranger Stickles Glitter Glue
