## you sick THING TREAT HOLDER

### You'll Need:

- You Sick Thing (N-9672-CL)
- 8.5" x 11" piece of colored cardstock
- 8.5" x 11" piece of patterned paper
- Light Blue Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Dark Red Cardstock
- Nestabilities Circle Dies
- Nestabilities Pinking Circle Die
- Memento Black Ink
- Redline Tape
- Foam mounting tape
- Copic Markers
- Bone folder
- Pencil & eraser
- Scissors

**1** Stamp image onto white cardstock and color in with Copic markers. Use Nestabilities die to cut around image. Layer with coordinating colors of cardstock cut with circle and pinking die. Set to the side.

**2** Stamp sentiment onto light blue cardstock. Take a pencil and hand-draw a 'word-bubble' around the sentiment phrase. Cut around the word bubble, and erase any visible pencil markings. Use foam mounting tape to adhere sentiment to image.

**3** Print out template directly onto the backsides of the colored cardstock and patterned paper. Using the solid lines, trim the body and bottom from the colored cardstock. Cut black notches out from bottom piece. Using the dotted top and bottom lines and solid sidelines, cut the body from the patterned paper.

**4** Adhere patterned paper body onto cardstock body. Start shaping body in a curve. *You may want to use a rubberband to help shape form.* Score and fold notched bottom piece. With notches folded up, put redline tape around the bottom piece. Do not remove backing yet.

**5** Take redline tape and line one side of the body. Remove redline tape backing from bottom and adhere to bottom edge of body. Before completely adhering the bottom to the body, remove redline tape from body and overlap sides. Adhere image layers to front of holder with foam mounting tape.

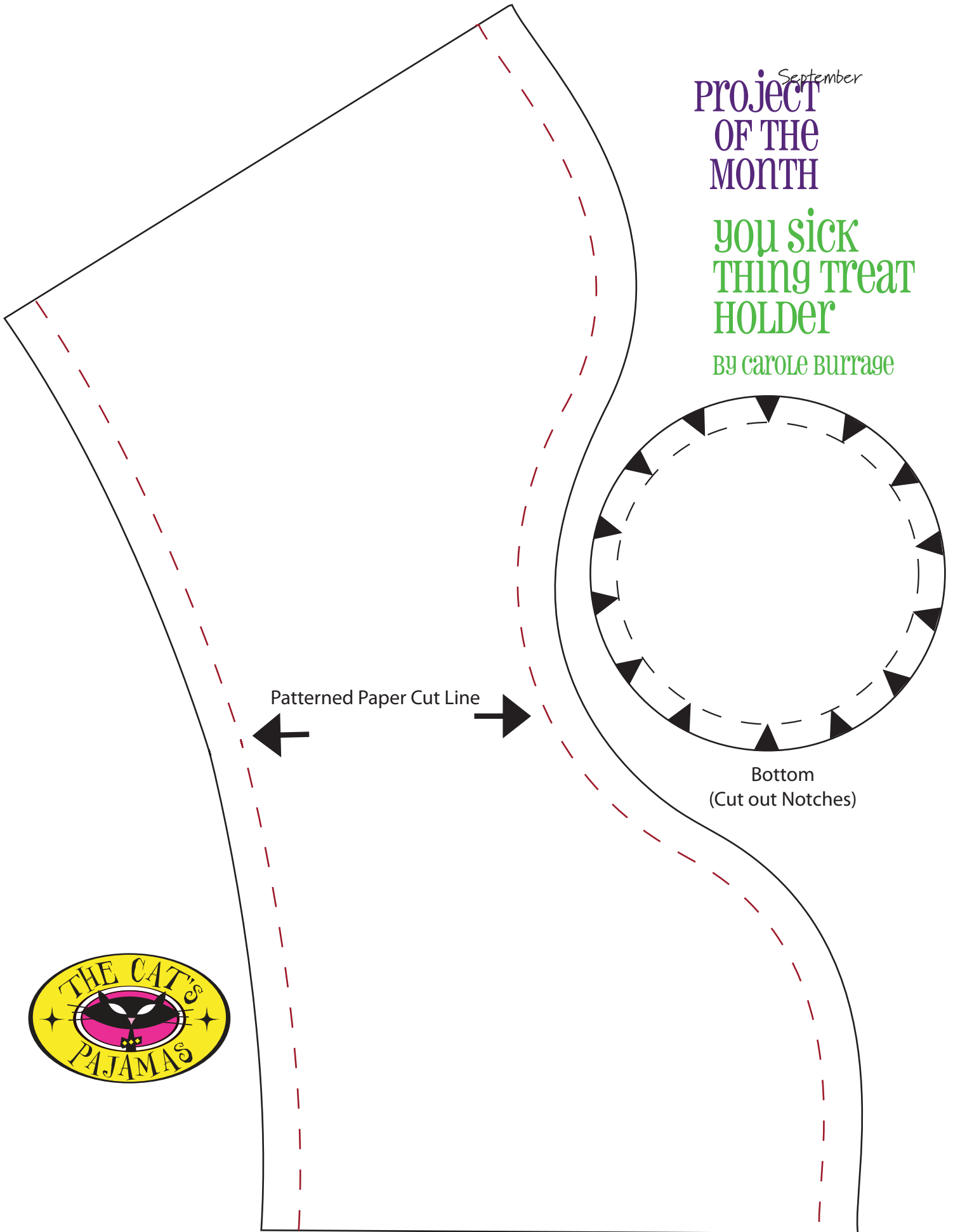
Fill with Pixie Stix or other treats.
